the bicycle cap was only available at the marc by marc jacobs shops in the U.S., paris and london.

this is the third exclusive series we had the pleasure to design especially for marc jacobs.

the bag is really light but the materials are rough and tough: inside-out denim and a super cotton (called "espiga" around here), made using a traditional loom... spanish style, the old fashioned way... the lining has classic squares and stripes (with two color options: red and blue), and there are four useful pockets.

it's a bag for boys and girls. treating this ukelele bag with love means folkin' daily use, wild nite "giving-it-all" and massive world (or neighbourhood) tours.

the pigs fabric was chosen by the MJ guys who fell in love with it when they visited our shop in madrid. so we embroidered their logo on it in light pink, while our logo was embroidered on the dollar fabric... pretty appropriate for these days we're living... hah.

in springtime we received an unexpected visit from new york. the guys from marc jacobs came to visit us right here to our shop in noviciado. they found our stuff somewhere and, as they were travelling around europe, they showed up in the hood...

it was decided to make a special edition of our tote bags (we called it in spanish "bolsaco" as a junction of the words "bolso", bag, and "saco", sack), the ones we already made with SuTurno, a spanish design studio, a year before this.

this exclusive edition of 100 tote bags was specially made to be found at the marc by marc jacobs shops around the u.s.: new york city (they sold out in less than a week), san francisco, los ángeles, las vegas, boston, chicago...

for this collaboration we used again the old sacks found in a warehouse downtown madrid and the costal fabric that makes us go crazy (we used it before with the museum kit collaboration)...

this edition came with a couple of goodies: a poster by SuTurno and a little yellow cotton bag by peSeta.
